PRE-JUNIOR

September 28, 2009 – March 29, 2010

Pre-junior is a learn-to-figure skate program taught in small groups by certified Skate Canada professional coaches with a focus on continual movement.

Skaters must have completed a minimum of CanSkate Stage 3* in order to participate.

Registration is limited to approximately 30 skaters per session, in order to maintain a ratio of approximately 5-8 skaters per coach.

**Skaters from clubs other than BFSC, who wish to advance to the Pre-Junior level must be evaluated by one of our coaches on registration day, September 13, 2009. Please phone Heather Young (Registrar) 514-693-3597 to schedule your evaluation.*

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

- Figure skates are compulsory
- Mittens or gloves.
- Helmets are optional.
- Skaters are required to wear clothing appropriate for figure skating, such as snug fitting leggings, or a skating dress for girls. Boys can wear skating pants or wind pants.
- No jeans, cords or baggy sweatpants are permitted.

USED SKATE AND DRESS SALE

A used skate and costume sale will be held during in-person registration, on Sunday, September 13th, 2009 from 2:00-4:00 pm in the upstairs lounge, Beaconsfield Recreation Centre. Coaches will be on hand at the skate sale to advise you on the suitability of your child's skates for the upcoming season.

If you have skates or skating costumes for sale, bring them to the Club room clearly marked with your name, phone number and price between 4:00 and 7:00 PM on Wednesday, September 9th, 2009. Pick up all articles on Sunday Sept 13 at 4 pm.

How often should I skate?

Figure skating is a technically demanding sport that requires adequate ice-time and instruction. At this level, it is recommended that a child skate twice a week. This could be two Pre-Junior sessions or a second option is to combine one day of Pre-junior with one day of private or semi-private lessons (StarSkate). Private and semi-private lessons must be booked directly with a professional coach of your choice. It is not a requirement to complete all 7 badges or participate in Pre-Junior before moving into private lessons. Inside the StarSkate program, there are opportunities for the skaters to take tests (judged against a national standard), participate in competitions, or just skate for fun!

For private and semi-private ice, each skater pays the Club for the use of the ice and lessons are booked directly with the coach of your choice.

Pre-Junior Information

Purchasing skates

Good quality new skates can be purchased at all of the following locations (excluding Dave Pitman)

(The majority of second hand figure skates sold at general sports stores are not suitable for pre-junior level skaters.)

Sharpening:

A poor quality *figure skate* sharpening can permanently damage the blade by removing the blade's rocker or toe picks which seriously diminishes the resale value of the skate as well as making it harder on the skater to learn new skills. It is worth the trip to have a good sharpening done! Please do not take your skates to a general sports store to be sharpened. Blades should be sharpened after approximately 20-24 hours of skating time.
