This competition is open to all United States Figure Skating and Skate Canada members and will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Figure Skating governing non-qualifying competitions, and will be governed by the official rules of the USFS as specified in the 2010 Rulebook, except as modified by this announcement.

## ENTRIES

Skaters may enter as many events as they are qualified for and must pay the entry fee for each event they enter. Skaters may skate their own level and/or any level above. The competition committee reserves the right to limit the size of each event, to combine or divide groups by age if necessary, and to cancel any event with fewer than two entrants, with refund of entry fees. **Entries MUST be postmarked by November 12, 2009.** ALL ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION OR THE APPLICATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Late entries or any requested changes after November 12, 2009, will be accepted at the discretion of the competition committee, with a **\$20.00** late fee assessed. **REQUESTS ARE NOT SOLICITED.**

## REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

Entry fees shall be refunded only with a physician's letter, or if entry is withdrawn before the closing date of entries, November 12, 2009, or if only one eligible competitor appears and the event is canceled. Any other refunds will be at the discretion of the Competition Committee. (Rule 3235)

## ELIGIBILITY

Skaters' eligibility will be determined by the highest freestyle, moves, or dance test **passed as of November 12, 2009.** Skaters may not compete below their test level but may compete at any higher level.

## **RINK SIZE**

Cheel Campus Center Arena's ice surface is 85' by 200'

## **MUSIC**

Competitors are to have their music for Free skating and/or Showcase events on a cassette tape (rewound on side to be played) or CD labeled with name and home club. Music must be recorded at the beginning of the tape. A duplicate tape or CD is suggested to avoid problems. Tape/CD is to be turned in at the registration desk and will be available at the registration desk for pick up after the event. The music for the dance and interpretive events will be supplied by the competition committee and only that music will be played. Vocal music is permitted for Badge and Preliminary Free skating and Showcase.

## **DOUBLE PANELS OF JUDGES**

The competition committee will attempt to provide full ice surface for as many events as possible. However, skaters should be prepared to use only 1/2 of the ice if necessary for Individual and Team Compulsory Moves. Double panels will be instituted at the discretion of the referee.

## **CRITIQUES**

Critiques will be available for all intermediate level and higher short and free skating programs and synchronized skating teams. Requests must be made on the application form.

## **AWARDS**

Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places; ribbons will be awarded for 4th and 5th places. 1st place synchronized skating teams at each level shall receive a team trophy. A team trophy will be awarded to the club that receives the most competition points - excluding synchronized skating. A schedule of team points will be posted. Award ceremonies will take place off the ice.

## **PUBLICITY DISCLAIMER**

The Potsdam Figure Skating Club reserves the right to photograph or videotape portions of the competition to use for promotional purposes.

## **SCHEDULE**

A schedule of event times should be available approximately 1 week prior to the competition date. Information will be faxed to the club fax number (space is provided on the application). It would be expected that the Competition or Test Chairs from each club would call for flight information for all competitors from their club. **Intermediate** - Must not have passed Novice (Canadian Jr. Silver) Free Skate Test. TIME: 2:30

**Novice** - Must not have passed Junior (Canadian Sr. Silver) Free Skate Test. TIME: Ladies - 3:00 Men - 3:30

**Junior** - Must not have passed Senior (Canadian Gold) Free Skate Test. TIME: Ladies - 3:30 Men - 4:00.

**Senior** - Must have passed Senior (Canadian Gold) Free Skate Test. TIME: Ladies - 4:00 Men - 4:30

**Adult** - Must be 21 or older as of November 12, 2009. The free skate will be based on the Adult Bronze and Silver Free Skate Tests. TIME: Time length for individual programs will be based on the level of each competitor.

### INTERPRETIVE LADIES' & MEN'S FREE SKATE EVENT

Divisions and qualifications are to be the same as for the Freeskate Event. The committee reserves the right to combine groups. Music will be 45 seconds to 1.5 minutes, depending on level of competition. Emphasis and judging of interpretive free skating will be on composition and style which includes interpretation of the music and words if applicable. Judges can be USFS judges and/or interested people from the community who may have little technical skating background. **Skaters are limited to three single jumps** (Axel allowed). Music selection will follow a holiday theme and will be varied according to skill level and supplied by the competition committee. No costumes or props are allowed.

## SHOWCASE EVENT

**Basis of Judging** - Performances will be judged solely on theatrical and artistic qualities from an entertainment standpoint. Technical skating skill and difficulty are not marked. Note, however, that skating must be the major element of the performance and of sufficient competence to support the theatrical components chosen. Judges can be USFS judges and/or interested people from the community who may have little technical skating background. Skaters are responsible for supplying their own music. Vocal music is permitted. Skaters will be judged in the following areas:

- a) **Choreography** (arrangement of steps, jumps, spins, etc.)
- b) **Music Interpretation** (expression of mood/theme of music)
- c) **Audience Appeal** (response)
- d) **Technical Merit** (style, flow and confidence of presentation)
- e) **Overall Performance**

**Costumes/Props** - Costumes receive no mark; however, they should be appropriate for the performance as they may improve or diminish the performance and thus have an effect on overall marking. For the safety of skaters, do not use feathers or dangling beads that may come off during the performance. Only hand-held props may be used. The referee has the right to disallow any prop as inappropriate.

**Performance Times** - Times listed are maximum performance times. There is no minimum time. If a performance exceeds the maximum time by more than ten seconds, that portion in excess will not be counted. Timing starts with the **first** motion of the body.

**Divisions** - Same eligibility as Free Skate. Each level can include men, ladies and groups. The competition committee reserves the right to combine divisions should low registration make it necessary.

**Intermediate:** 2:00 maximum

**Pre-Preliminary:** 1:00 maximum

**Novice:** 2:00 maximum

**Preliminary:** 1:30 maximum

**Junior:** 2:30 maximum

**Senior:** 2:30 maximum

**Juvenile:** 1:30 maximum

**Adult:** 2:00 maximum

## FOOTWORK EVENT

Skaters perform footwork sequences of their own design to music of their choice. The program should contain a variety of turns and sequences and emphasize the skater's controlled edges and turns in addition to speed and quickness of the routine. The program may contain one-half rotation jumps and spins with fewer than three revolutions. The routine will be judged on both technical merit and presentation.

**Preliminary:** Passed no higher than Preliminary Free; 1:10 maximum

**PreJuvenile/Juvenile:** Passed no higher than Juvenile Free; 1:10 maximum

**Intermediate/Novice:** Passed no higher than Novice Free; 1:10 maximum

**Junior/Senior:** Passed Junior Free; 1:10 maximum

## INDIVIDUAL COMPULSORY MOVES EVENT

Same eligibility as Free Skate. Movements are confined to those listed and **SHOULD** be done in the order listed. All moves must be included. Movements must be continuous, using connecting steps necessary to link the various elements. Combination jumps **may not** have a step or turn between. No music will be used. Judging will be based on technical merit only. Skaters should be prepared to use only 1/2 of the ice, if necessary, as this event may be double paneled as determined by the referee.

**Badge A:** Forward crossovers, any stop, skating backward, forward pumping, gliding on one foot.

**Badge B:** Two bunny hops, backward crossovers, forward spiral, gliding backward on one foot, one foot spin.

**Pre-Preliminary:** Half flip, forward spiral, waltz jump, one foot spin, lunge.

**Preliminary:** Loop, backward spiral, salchow, scratch spin, waltz jump-toe loop combination.

**Pre-Juvenile:** Lutz, camel spin, combination jump (one must be a loop), forward and/or backward spiral, camel to sit spin (no change of foot and minimum of six revolutions).

**Juvenile:** Layback spin (male may substitute cross-foot spin), flip, loop-loop combination, combination spin with change of foot, forward and/or backward spiral.

**Intermediate:** Axel, change foot spin (minimum 4 revolutions per foot), two jump combination (one of which must be an Axel), combination spin with one change of foot and one change of position (minimum of 4 revolutions per foot), Ina Bauer.

**Novice:** Axel, combination spin consisting of one change of foot and one change of position (minimum of 5 revolutions per foot), double-single jump combination, double loop, circular footwork.

**Junior:** Double flip, flying camel, double Salchow, combination spin with one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of 5 revolutions per foot), jump combination with at least one double.

**Senior:** Double Axel or double Lutz, flying spin, double/double jump combination, combination spin with one change of foot and two changes of position (minimum of 5 revolutions per foot), double flip.

## SHORT PROGRAM

Same eligibility as Free Skate.

**Intermediate:** Time not to exceed 2:00

**Novice:** Time not to exceed 2:30

**Junior:** Time not to exceed 2:50

**Senior:** Time not to exceed 2:50

## INDIVIDUAL MOVES IN THE FIELD EVENT

Moves-in-the-Field level passed as of November 12, 2009. Judging will be based on criteria stated in the USFS Rulebook, including power, extension, edge quality and quickness.

**Pre-Preliminary:** (Must not have passed Preliminary Moves in the Field): RFO-LFO Consecutive Edges, RBI-LBI Consecutive Edges, RFO-LFO Waltz Eights (2 patterns on each foot).

**Preliminary:** (Must not have passed Pre-Juvenile Moves in the Field): Consecutive Outside and Inside Spirals, Forward Power Three-Turns, Alternating Forward Three-Turns.

**Pre-Juvenile:** (Must not have passed Juvenile Moves in the Field): FO/BI 3-Turns in the Field, Forward Power Change of Edge Pulls, Five Step Mohawk Sequence.

**Juvenile:** (Must not have passed Intermediate Moves in the Field): Forward Free Skating Cross Strokes, Forward Double Three-Turns, Eight Step Mohawk Sequence (Counter-Clockwise).

**Intermediate:** (Must not have passed Novice Moves in the Field): Stroking: Forward Power Circle, Backward Double 3-Turns, Inside Slide Chassé Pattern.

**Novice:** (Must not have passed Junior Moves in the Field): Forward Outside Counter, Backward Rocker Choctaw Sequence, Spiral Sequence.

**Junior:** (Must not have passed Senior Moves in the Field): Stroking: Backward Power Circles, Forward Inside Rockers, Backward Choctaw Sequence.

**Senior:** Sustained Edge Step, Extension Spiral Step, Backward Outside Power Double 3-Turns to Power Double Inside Rockers.

## INDIVIDUAL COMPULSORY SPIN EVENT

Skaters will skate a program without music. There will be a deduction for any jumps done. Programs can be no longer than the stated times, but may be shorter without penalty. Footwork sequences are allowed to connect spins. The number of revolutions noted is the minimum required after achieving the appropriate spin position. Badge through Juvenile may be done on 1/2 ice.

**Badge:** (Must not have passed either Skate With Us Freestyle 4/ Can Skate Freestyle VI or USFS Pre-Preliminary/Canadian Preliminary Free Skate Test.) 1. One-foot spin (3 rev.) 2. Two-foot spin (3 rev.)  
**Time: 1:00**

**Pre-Preliminary:** (Must not have passed the Preliminary Free Skate Test.) 1. Scratch spin (3 rev.) 2. Two-foot spin (3 rev.) 3. Sit spin (3 rev.) **Time: 1:00.**

**Preliminary:** (Must not have passed the Pre-Juvenile Free Skate Test.) 1. One-foot upright spin, optional free foot position (3 rev.) 2. One-foot back spin (3 rev.) 3. Sit spin (3 rev.) **Time: 1:30**

**Pre-Juvenile:** (Must not have passed the Juvenile Free Skate Test.) 1. Camel spin (3 rev.) 2. Camel to sit spin, no change in foot (6 rev.) 3. Combination spin with one change of foot, no change of position (3 rev.) **Time: 1:30**

**Juvenile:** (Must not have passed the Intermediate Free Skate Test.) 1. Forward sit spin (4 rev.) 2. One combination spin with one change of foot and one change of basic position (4 rev. on each foot) 3. Ladies - layback or attitude spin (4 rev.); Men - Camel spin (4 rev.) **Time: 1:30**

**Intermediate:** (Must not have passed the Novice Free Skate Test.) 1. Sit spin to change foot sit spin (minimum 4 rev each foot, in position). 2. Camel (minimum 5 rev in position). 3. Combination spin: one change foot and one change of position (minimum 4 rev. each foot). **Time: 1:30**

## INDIVIDUAL COMPULSORY SPIN EVENT (CONTINUED)

**Novice:** (Must not have passed the Junior Free Skate Test.) 1. Choice of camel, sit or layback spin (minimum 6 rev. in position). 2. Camel to back camel (minimum 4 rev. each foot in position). 3. Combination spin: one change foot and one change position (minimum 5 rev. each foot). **Time: 2:00**

**Junior:** (Must not have passed the Senior Free Skate Test.) 1. Flying sit spin or flying change (reverse) sit spin (6 rev. in position) 2. Layback or cross-foot spin (6 rev.) 3. Combination spin consisting of three positions and one change of foot (5 rev. on each foot). **Time: 2:00**

**Senior:** 4 spins (solo spins must be minimum of 6 rev. in position). 1. Flying spin. 2. Spin combination consisting of at least two positions and at least one change of foot (minimum of 10 total rev.) 3 & 4 Competitor's Choice **Time: 2:00.**

## TEAM COMPULSORY MOVES EVENT

Same eligibility as Free Skate. This event consists of teams of 3 to 5 skaters (male and/or female) representing one club. No skater may perform more than two moves. A skater may compete on ONE team in each division, and may compete in more than one division. Skaters should be prepared to use only 1/2 of the ice if it becomes necessary. Each element should be performed in the center of the ice surface being used. An element may be repeated; however if repeated, the second attempt will be judged (not the first).

**Badge A:** Backward skating, forward crossovers, gliding on one foot, any stop, waltz jump.

**Badge B:** Mohawk, spiral, two foot spin, shoot the duck, and two bunny hops.

**Pre-Preliminary:** Salchow, waltz jump, spiral, one-foot spin, toe loop.

**Preliminary:** Spiral, scratch spin, flip, Salchow, waltz jump-toe loop combination.

**Pre-Juvenile:** Lutz, loop, front scratch to back scratch spin, camel spin, combination jump (one must be a loop).

**Juvenile:** Sit spin, Axel, loop-loop combination jump, combination spin, forward and/or backward spiral.

**Intermediate:** Axel, layback spin, change foot spin, double Salchow, two jump combination (one must be a double toe loop).

**Novice:** Axel, double loop, two jump combination, combination spin which includes a camel, circular footwork.

**Junior/Senior:** Flying camel, Ina Bauer, flying sit spin, double Lutz, combination jump (including a double flip).

**Adult:** Must be 21 or older as of November 12, 2009. Each team will select five elements: two spins, two jumps, and one free choice. Judging will be based on the level of each competitor

# SOLO DANCE EVENT

Ladies and men will compete in the same event. The Competition Committee will select the music and only that music will be played.

**Preliminary:** May have passed one Pre-Bronze Dance (Canadian Jr. Bronze). **Dance:** Dutch Waltz

**Pre-Bronze:** May have passed one Bronze Dance (Canadian Jr. Bronze). **Dance:** Swing Dance

**Bronze:** May have passed one Pre-Silver Dance (Canadian Sr. Bronze). **Dance:** Willow Waltz

**Pre-Silver:** May have passed one Silver Dance (Canadian Jr. Silver). **Dance:** Foxtrot

**Silver:** May have passed one Pre-Gold Dance (Canadian Sr. Silver). **Dance:** Tango

**Pre-Gold:** May have passed one Gold Dance (Canadian Gold). **Dance:** Blues

**Gold:** No restrictions on skater's level. **Dance:** Kilian

**Adult:** Must be over age 21. **Dance:** Based on the level of each competitor, one or more levels of dance may be selected.

NOTE: All USFS teams must be registered with the USFS for the current year. The registration number will be required on the application for all precision teams entered. All ages are determined as of 7/1/09.

**Preliminary:** 8 to 16 skaters; Under age 12 with a majority of the team being under 10 years. Time: 2:00

**Juvenile:** 12 to 20 skaters; under age 13. Time: 3:00

**Intermediate:** 12 to 20 skaters. Skaters must be under the age of 18. Time: 3:30

**Novice:** 12 to 20 skaters; Under the age of 16. Time: 3:30

**Junior:** 12 to 16 skaters; must have reached the age of 12 and must not have reached the age of 19.  
Time: Long 4:00 Short 2:40

**Senior:** 16 skaters; must have reached the age of 14 Time: 4:30 Short: 2:40

**Collegiate:** 12 to 20 skaters; must be enrolled in a college/university degree program as full-time students.  
Time: 4:00

**PreJuvenile :** 8-12 skaters; The majority of the team must be under 12 years of age. Time: 2:00

**Open Juvenile:** 8-12 skaters; The majority of the team must be under the age of 19. Time: 2:30

**Open Junior:** 12-20 skaters; must be 12 years of age with a majority of the team being under the age of 19.  
Time: 4:00

**Open Collegiate:** 8-16 skaters; Must be enrolled in a degree program at a college or university. Team members may be full-time or part-time students. Time: 3:00

**Adult:** 12-20 skaters; Skaters must be 21 or older with a majority of skaters being 25 or older. Time: 3:30
